

**Plant:** Yellow (Common) Toadflax  
*Linaria vulgaris*

**Perennial**

**NOXIOUS**

**Growth:** 8-24 Inches

**I.D.** Leaves are pale green to green, gray  
Leaves are numerous and all attached to stem  
Leaves are long and narrow  
Snapdragon-like flower  
Flowers are pale yellow with a brighter yellow or orange throat  
Flowers have a downward pointing spur about 1 inch long

**Other:** Both Yellow and its cousin Dalmation Toadflax  
are escaped ornamental flowers  
Each plant can produce 8,700 seeds that germinate in the  
top inch of soil.  
It was introduced to North America in the 1800s
