Marvel and Roddy said they would be in charge of getting the round robin judges.

Sharon let us know that due to the fact the extension office was having difficulty getting pictures for the herdsman award plaques, the picture of the people whom the award is named after would be placed on them.

Wanda informed us that the Fair Board is not allowing any dogs in the barn other than during the dog show.

Norton moved to adjourn. Marvel seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
