

## Livestock Committee Minutes

### **Old Business:**

MQA update- Sharon sent letters to everyone that needed their Beef Quality Assurance updated. The test is online and also in the letters that were sent out.

The ultra sounding was not pursued so we have dropped it.

### **New Business:**

Buyer Invites- Sharon has a rough draft in case of any corrections that needed to be made. Sharon told us that there are approximately 250 buyers and 33 youth so she will be sending out at least 5 buyer invites per member. Roddy Rost suggested that youth send out 5 invites per animal.

Round Robin Judges- We need people to volunteer to be Round Robin Judges. Cindy Irgens also brought up the idea to have a Small Animal Round Robin or incorporating it into regular Round Robin. Cindy is going to look into it for next year's fair.

Hay for Fair was discussed- Roddy Rost gladly volunteered to donate hay for the fair.

Livestock Sale- We discussed all of the jobs and responsibilities and found some people that hopefully will help us out.

We discussed the fact that Paul has moved the poultry back to the end of the cattle pens. We would like Paul to come to a Livestock Meeting or a Super 6 Meeting for further discussion on placement of animals.

Roddy informed us that at the Fair Board Meeting they decided that there will be no parking right next to the barn on the north or south side.

Leslie Gray inquired about the carcass and trailer shows.

Sharon asked about the fans and scaffold so that we can find and use them for fair.

Cindy brought the t-shirt prints and asked for opinions so that she can get them ordered. She also brought up the Herdsman Award and that it would be cool if we could get a local company to do it. Sharon asked if Willie could ask Boyd for 6 or 7 employees from WBI.
