Requirements:

2. No limitations of major course of study.
3. May attend any accredited school of higher learning in any state.
4. Minimum GPA of 2.5 upon completion of high school is necessary.
5. Winners of scholarships must show proof of a minimum GPA of 2.5 from the first semester of continuing education and proof of enrollment in the second semester to be eligible to receive their scholarship.
6. Those entering their first year of post-high school education, and must be a current high school senior or have graduated the year prior to applying.

Deadline:

Completed application must be in the Fallon/Carter Extension Office by **5:00 p.m. on May 1.**
