The March 2019 meeting of the Fallon County Weed Board was called to order on the night of the 11<sup>th</sup>, by Chairman Bruha at 7:05PM. Those members present were as follows; Bruha, Wolenetz, Wyrick, board secretary Butori took minutes.

The board was given time prior to the meeting to read and review the minutes and budget report from the previous month. 
