

Landfill Rules and Regulations

Hours: Monday – Friday 7:30-4:00
Loads will **NOT be accepted past 3:30**

Welcome to the Coral Creek Landfill. Please read and observe the following rules to ensure your visit is as smooth and safe as possible.

- Please be aware that the landfill may shut down due to high winds, rain/mud, or other inclement weather. If the decision is made, it will be announced on the radio. We will reopen as soon as possible. If you are unsure if the landfill is closed, please feel free to call Jeff the Manager at 1-(406)-978-2734 (c) or the landfill office at 1-(406)-778-2734.
- Use the landfill at your own risk. If you get stuck, please note that it is against Fallon County's policy to use any of our equipment to help pull you out. The landfill employees are not allowed to use equipment to help unload trucks/trailers or flip containers.
- The landfill is operated by a small crew. We are not always in the office. If you need help, the Weighmaster and Manager cell phone numbers are listed on the counter and both doors. Please feel free to call either number for assistance.
- For the regular drivers who fill out the weight sheet themselves, please fill out the sheet accurately and legibly. This includes time of delivery, drivers name, account to be billed, waste type, state of origin and the weight. (the scale display is on the wall to the left above the printer)
- Please be observant of any moving equipment/vehicles. We utilize several types of machinery and vehicles. Please do **NOT** pass any piece of equipment going the same direct as you. If there is a piece of equipment working where you need to dump, please wait for them off to the side and give them plenty of space to work. We will give a "thumbs up" when you are clear to unload.
- Please be observant when our tub grinder is working. This machine has a large debris throw area. If you are needing to get to the tree pile or compost area, please wait for the operator to give you the ok or find another operator to get ahold of the person operating the tub grinder.
- The landfill is a smoke, drug, and alcohol-free site.
- White goods such as washers and dryers are accepted. There is a brown G&G garbage container near our shop, please unload them next to the container and we will put them in the container.
- White goods such as refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners must have a certification sticker on them stating the refrigerant has been removed by a certified person. If they are not drained, they will **NOT** be accepted.
- All loads to the landfill **MUST** be secured and/or tarped. Per the account setup sheet, loads that are not secured/tarped are subject to being double charged.
- When traveling to the landfill, please use Coral Creek Road. Please be observant for any UTV/crew members that are out picking trash off the road/ditches.

- All material must be cut to a length no longer than 8'. Anything longer than that can become a hazard to our equipment and operators.
- Billing is done at the first of the month, which includes an invoice and a copy of every ticket for the month.
- If a bill remains unpaid for 60 days, a statement will be issued. Failure to pay after the statement has been issued will result in the account being suspended and placed under a "cash only" account or will be refused to use the landfill until payment is made.
